Whenever we go on a Mission Trip, or like we did in July a Youth Gathering, we always make themed shirt. We often have the kids pick the colors and by tradition we always have the kids tie dye one. We do these shirts for a few reasons. On Mission Trips it gives the kids a shirt that they can get dirty and muddy or get paint all over so that they don't worry about having to ruin any of the own clothes. At the same time, for all of the trips it gives the kids an automatic souvenir and keepsake of their trip. It is always cool to see them wearing the shirts around after the trip. I actually just found one of my shirts from the 2009 Youth Gathering and it brought back good memories and even better, it still fit!

Also, these shirts often make us stand out. On Mission Trips we are often with other groups and they don't have themed shirts and that sometimes sets us apart and often they are somewhat jealous of our shirts. At a Youth Gathering, however, it actually makes us blend in and we are part of a great sea of colors. Someone once described it as looking out and seeing human Skittles. At the Youth Gathering, seeing so many people in colorful t-shirts was actually a great way of connecting as we compared our different shirts and showing our own uniqueness and individuality.

In Romans 10:12 it says, "For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; the same Lord is Lord of all and is generous to all who call on him." We do spend a lot of time in our lives trying to separate ourselves from others and trying to stand out. But at the same time, there is so much that unites us. We are each unique, but we also need the same Lord. For we need the same love, the same grace, the same forgiveness, the same salvation. It doesn't matter the color of shirt we wear or even if we are all wearing the same shirt. Our Lord is the Lord of all.

We could do to remember that. One of the things I love about working with youth is sometimes they don't really care what color of shirt you are wearing. Even better, they often might be interested and curious because you are wearing something different than them and they want to find out about it. Instead of being afraid of something or someone different than yourself, maybe be open to it. Be willing to engage. To learn. And to remember that Jesus is not only your Savior, but their Savior as well. No matter what color shirt they wear.

### What you need:

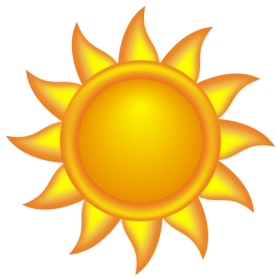
- Large bowl
